



## Quick Connect Gifts:

“For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—  
and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—  
not by works, so no one can boast.  
For we are God’s workmanship,  
created in Christ Jesus to do good works,  
which God prepared in advance for us to do.”  
Ephesians 2:8-10 (NIV)

All gifts come from God.

“Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows.” James 1:17 (NIV)

All gifts are given according to God’s grace.

“Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others, faithfully administering God’s grace in its various forms.” 1 Peter 4:10 (NIV)

“But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me did not prove vain; but I labored even more than all of them, yet not I, but the grace of God with me.”  
1 Corinthians 15:10 (NAS)

As we grow God begins to transform our lives.

“Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God’s mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God—this is your spiritual act of worship. Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God’s will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.” Romans 12:1-2 (NIV)

Transformation occurs when we:

1. Inflow
2. Outflow

God sets each member in His church as He purposed.

The Holy Spirit gives His gifts as He wills.

1. Gifts are given to flawed men and women.

“And He gave some as apostles, and some as prophets, and some as evangelists, and some as pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ...” Ephesians 4:11-12 (NAS)

Purpose: Equipping the Saints...for works of service...  
so that the body might be built up.

2. Spiritual Gifts: 1 Corinthians 11-14

Purpose: Others might be comforted, encouraged, & built up.

3. Motivational Gifts: Romans 12 (talents, abilities, our wiring, our sweet spot, our strengths, our leaning, our intuitiveness)
